









Instructions For Use

Falcon*Media* offers the most reliable and highest quality CD-R, DVD±R and DVD+R DL recording optical media. All Falcon*Media* optical discs are specified as, professional top grade media with guaranteed archival performance. This combination ensures the highest read/write performance at all speeds, excellent compatibility with modular drives, resulting in a reliable, consistent quality recording and extended lifespan for recorded data.

Disc handling

- Protect the recording surface of the discs from scratches, fingerprints, dust and smears
- Hold the disc along the outer edges or center hole
- Never touch the recording surface, printed label surface, or place the disc facedown on a hard surface
- Clean dirty discs with soft, dry cloth. Commercially available disc cleaner may also be used
- Do not use other chemicals or solvents for cleaning, as they may damage the recording surface of the optical disc

Conservation

- Avoid using or storing the discs in an environment with high temperature or humidity.
- Recommended storage: 23°C ± 2°C, 50% RH ± 5% RH
- Avoid exposure to a direct sunlight or strong light
- The product has a flat surface on the label side. If the products have been stored in a pile for long time, they may stick together, especially after storage under higher temperature and humidity conditions. Manual shuffling of piled discs before use in auto handling systems is recommended.
- It is recommended that the discs remain sealed in disc holder until used. This will protect the unrecorded discs from damage.

Traceability

The product code, batch number are printed on each optical disc, while the part number and production lot are found on the label placed on the product packaging. Such information is required by FTI in the event of a complaint.

Warranty

Falcon Technologies International warrants that Falcon Media product will be free from defects in material and workmanship for its normal useful life, if properly handled, used and maintained. If this product proves defective in either material or workmanship, it will be exchanged free of charge. This warranty does not apply to defects caused by accident, abnormal use, misuse, improper handling, improper storage, or normal wear or tear.

Disposal and safety

Falcon *Media* optical discs, including the packaging and packaging components, conform to the European Directive 2011/65/EU limiting the use of hazardous substance in electric and electronic equipment (RoHS). The media can be disposed off with plastic waste for recycling.
